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Introduction

Today we celebrate Father's Day!

There is a great need in our society for fathers who will rise up and assume their God-given role of responsibility in the family.

Micah 6:8
He has shown you, O man, what *is* good;
And what does the Lord require of you
But to do justly,
To love mercy,
And to walk humbly with your God.

Introduction

Micah 6:8 gives the basic responsibility for manhood. To treat others justly, to show mercy, and walk in humility with God.

However, when a man becomes a father, those responsibilities are expanded.

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A Godly Father Loves God

Matthew 6:33

But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

This is the foundation that all of the rest of life is built upon.

It is easy to say that you love God but take a moment to evaluate (not justify) your life. How much of your life is dedicated to living a life that demonstrates your love for God.

A Godly Father Loves God Loving God is not something you add into your life, it is to be your life!

Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with <u>all</u> your heart, with <u>all</u> your soul, and with <u>all</u> your mind."

Proverbs 3:6

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A Godly Father Loves God

Here is REALITY!

If you do not have a right relationship with God, it is futile to think you can have a right relationship with others.

If you are not following God with all that you have, then you will not be be living out of a Biblical mindset, but one that is contaminated with the world.

You will not be able to be a Godly Father, Husband, or Friend as long as you live a "double minded" life.

A Godly Father Loves God

If you are running from God, you need to settle this matter. You will never find the true love, peace, and joy that is found in a close personal relationship with God until you do.

Isaiah 57:21
"There is no peace,"
Says my God, "for the wicked."

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A Godly Father Loves his Wife

Ephesians 5:25-29

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, ²⁶ that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. ²⁸ So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. ²⁹ For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church.

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A Godly Father Loves his Wife

Real love seeks to meet all the needs of another person. When a Godly husband loves his wife, he is willing to sacrifice his own wants and desires to see that the needs of his wife are met. Husbands are to love their wives sacrificially just as Jesus loved the church and was willing to die so that the believers could be freed from sin and death.

Romantic actions are not an abandonment of manliness.

Show acts of kindness and respect to you wife. Open the car door, pull out her chair at dinner, hold her hand, and help with the household chores. Look around and see how you can help. Show you love through:

Acts of kindness
Giving of quality time
Sharing words of tenderness
Tender touch
Giving gifts

how to treat their wives. One day they

You are teaching by example! Lead well.

things. Don't miss your children's
childhood.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9

⁶ "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. ⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. ⁸You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.
