Creation – 4 Rock

Introduction

We are examining how God spoke (inspired) Creation into existence.

God took seven days to create and rest as a teaching ministry to us. There are three primary reasons God took 7 days.

- 1. God taught us a work cycle and the importance of rest.
 - 2. God shows the progression of our Salvation.
 - 3. God used the days of Creation to teach of Jesus.

Today we will begin to look at the Days of Creation.

Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry *land* appear"; and it was so. ¹⁰ And God called the dry *land* Earth, and the gathering together of the waters He called Seas. And God saw that *it was* good. ¹¹ Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb *that* yields seed, *and* the fruit tree *that* yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed *is* in itself, on the earth"; and it was so. ¹² And the earth brought forth grass, the herb *that* yields seed according to its kind, and the tree *that* yields fruit, whose seed *is* in itself according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good. ¹³ So the evening and the morning were the third day.

God has a goal in mind – the creation of man. In order for man and animals to survive, he will need ground to walk on and food to eat.

Earth and water is foundational to life. Earth, air, and water contain the building blocks for plants to make essential molecules (amino acids, nucleic acids, and sugars) that are essential for life.

Luke 19:40

But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

This verse is in the context of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. It was a declaration that He was coming as the Messiah. The people were excited and crying out. The religious leaders, having rejected Him, feared the Romans response. These leaders called on Jesus to tell the crowds to be quiet. This verse is His reply.

Skeptics have used this verse to mock the Bible stating that stones cannot speak.

Though not in the context of the verse, matter has the ability to absorb sound vibrations. These work on a half-life scale, and never reach zero. Our speech is embedded, like light, in the very fabric of the universe. We do not have the ability to pull it out, but God can. Every word and conversation you have ever said can be pulled out and testify against you. We have all sinned!

For the stone will cry out from the wall, And the beam from the timbers will answer it.

I believe that the stones cry out that Jesus is the creator and tell of the things that He has done.

Job 12:8 states, "Speak to the earth and it will teach you." What does the earth teach?

Most rocks are sedimentary in their make-up. That is, they are made of sediments, tiny pieces re-cemented together from previous rocks. One could even call them "destroyed rocks." A full 75% of the rocks of the outer crust of the earth are sedimentary; the Grand Canyon is almost all sedimentary rock.

And where there is that kind of rock, there has been water.

The geologic column, a science model to understand the earth's geologic history, contains the "inerrant history of the earth." However, it contains data only; it is left to us to interpret that data. And depending upon one's worldview, you can come up with many different views.

Evolution states that the geological column shows the progression of life though the ages. They interpret the different layers as representing millions of years of history.

There are major problems with this view.

When Mt. Saint Helens exploded, it took a cubic mile of rock and dirt, mixing it with water and laid down strata (layers) of rock similar to the Grand Canyon. By evolutionary standards, millions of years of strata were laid down in 9 minutes.

There are major problems with this view.

The great sandstone layers of the Grand Canyon were laid down by water in a single act. The grains of sand at the bottom are larger and gradate down to finer at the top.

This is evidence of a single deposition.

The strata are not in the right order and many layers are missing in areas or even backward.

Radiometric dating is an attempt to see how old a rock is. There are three assumptions:

- 1. That we know the starting point
- 2. That there is no migration of atoms
- 3. That the decay rates are constant

The reality, is that rock does not lay down a pure substance, atoms migrate, and decay rates vary with regard to environment.

> Robert Gentry, discovered a system for properly dating rocks. Radiometric halos are the microscopic scaring of the rock when a radioactive atom degrades.

Each ring represents a known step in the decay sequence. From these rings, one can calculate the starting point and account for any migration. Even when one uses the evolutionary decay rate, they still yield very young ages for the earth.

You would think that Mr. Gentry would get a Nobel Prize, instead he was fired because his work contradicted evolution!
