# Creation – 7 Fish & Birds

#### Introduction

We are examining how God spoke (inspired) Creation into existence.

God took seven days to create and rest as a teaching ministry to us. There are three primary reasons God took 7 days.

- 1. God taught us a work cycle and the importance of rest.
  - 2. God shows the progression of our Salvation.
  - 3. God used the days of Creation to teach of Jesus. Today we continue to look at the Days of Creation.

Genesis 1:20-23

Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens." <sup>21</sup> So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good. <sup>22</sup> And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." <sup>23</sup> So the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

On the first three days of Creation, God made spaces. On Days 4-6 He filled those spaces.

Day 1 – The Heavens	Day 4 – Sun, Moon, Stars
Day 2 – Atmosphere and Seas	Day 5 – Flying and Swimming creatures
Day 3 – Land and Plants	Day 6 – Land animals and Man

Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens." <sup>21</sup> So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good. <sup>22</sup> And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." <sup>23</sup> So the evening and the morning were the fifth day.

This is the first time that the word "living" is used. We have "living creatures" and "living things." Science is unable to define life. The best it can do is to list the attributes of living things. Life cannot be weighed and when it is gone, man is helpless to restore it. Life is a gift from God. He is the one that gives life.

On Day 5 God (Jesus) filled the spaces of air and sea with a great diversity of creatures.

God had to create the habitats before creating the creature. When birds were created, they had places to fly, food to eat, and trees in which to build their nests. The same was true for those creatures living in the sea.

All kinds of creatures live in the sea—some of the smallest and some of the largest, some that are very beautiful, and some that are bizarre or odd. The smallest creatures that live in the sea are tiny, microscopic, single-celled forms of life, such as bacteria, protozoa, and algae. These break down waste to keep the ocean clean and add oxygen and other nutrients into the water. They are also food.

God also created invertebrates include sponges, jellyfish, clams, oysters, sea urchins, sea cucumbers, starfish, sea lilies, lobsters, worms, snails, and many more.

Many mammals live in the ocean such as whales and dolphins. It is important to know that these were created before land animals which contradicts evolution.

Marine Dinosaurs were also created on Day 5. Ancient mariner map are often decorated with creatures that resemble marine dinosaurs – they used sailing ships that are quiet as they slip through the water. We also find pottery decorated with creatures that resemble known kinds of dinosaurs. What were they looking at?

In April 1977, the Japanese fishing trawler *Zuiyo-maru* operating off the coast of New Zealand snagged a large carcass at a depth of about 1,000 feet. The carcass was brought to the surface and onto the ship. The dead creature was about 33 feet long and weighed about 4,000 pounds. Scientists around the world believe that it could be a plesiosaur, however American Evolutionary Scientists reject this idea.

Japan actually printed a postage stamp commemorating the discovery of the plesiosaur carcass.

God also created flying things. This would have been things like birds but could also include flying dinosaurs.

Birds are marvels of engineering.

They have specialized feather for flight, each feather is controlled by its own muscle. Its bones are hollow but reinforced with cross members for maximum strength. The "wishbone" protects the internal organs from being crushed by the force of the wing muscles. The list could go on.

Archaeopteryx has been considered the first bird, yet it had fully developed flight feathers and wishbone. It should be added that fossils of modern birds have been found in strata that are older than archaeopteryx.
