Our Former Future

As a result of our sin and rebellion, we were cut off from God. We were under the judgment of that sin. The wages of our sin is death. Death means separation. The 1st death is separation from physical life which is a picture of what is to come. The 2nd death is separation from God and all that it is good. God prepared "Hell" for the Angelic realm that rebelled against Him. Since mankind joined that rebellion, we share that same fate.

Our Former Future

Jesus warned more about the consequences of Hell more then He did about the glories of Heaven. It is a place of pain and suffering as God's wrath is poured upon sin. There is nothing good there – no pleasure, relief, joy, love, forever and ever.

This is the future of everyone if God did not intervene in the affairs of men.

A Serious Choice

God is Love and does not delight in the destruction of the wicked (Ezekiel 33:11; 2 Peter 3:9; Titus 2:11). He desires all men to come to repentance (1 Timothy 2:4). Love and worship are choices. We choose to love and worship God.

God made the initial choice to love mankind when we were unlovely in our sin. He chose to do what we could not. His love moved Him to send Jesus to pay the debt for our sin and open a way of restoration.

A Different Judgment

The unsaved will stand before God in the Great White Throne Judgment. Their lives will be judged to reveal their sin and rejection of God (Revelation 20:11-15). The unbelievers will be confirmed in their sin and separated from God as they are cast into the Lake of Fire.

Those in Christ have a different judgment. Our lives will also be evaluated. This time it is not to confirm our sin as Jesus dealt with that on the cross. It is to try our lives to evaluate if we lived for God or lived for self. This is the Bema Seat of Christ (2 Corinthians 5:10).

A Future Reward

At this judgment we will receive the rewards for serving and living for Christ. Motivations matter! Our service here must be more than just performance. Jesus taught that the Pharisees had their reward for they did their works for the applause of men.

The believer's life will be tried (1 Peter 1:7) and the things that have been done for Christ will remain. The Bible speaks of many different types of rewards (crowns). Some of these seem to be tangible, while others a spiritual.

A New Relationship

God wants people to make the choice to love and worship Him.

He desires that we come to know Him. This is more than knowledge about Him, but to experience a relationship with Him.

To be a True Christian is more than going through a series of rituals or traditions. It is more than just acknowledging the historical realities of Jesus and the cross. Even the Devil knows these things (James 2:19).

John 17:3

And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

Perfected / Glorified

Romans 8:16-17
